## **TOURNAMENT RULES Tournament Director:** Patrick Curran

#### Check-in

Team rosters must be delivered to the administration tent at least 30 minutes before your first game. Teams will also be provided with gatorade/snacks upon check-in.

USGAA Junior C/D Hurling and Camogie rules apply, except as otherwise stated here or agreed to with the Tournament Director.

All participants must be USGAA registered to play
Each club must submit a roster of all players BEFORE the start of their first match. Please use the **provided roster sheet**, and indicate Irish-born or Homegrown, and Jersey number for the day.

#### **Tournament Points:**

- Win = 2 points
- Tie = 1 point
- Loss = 0 points

Pool standings determine which teams play in the semi-finals and final matches; standings will be determined as follows:

1. Tournament Points

If tied on tournament points, then winner of previous head to head
 If head to head was a draw, then the number of goals scored in the tournament

4. If still tied, then coin toss

# **TOURNAMENT RULES**

#### - Match referee decisions are final.

- All players, coaches, spectators, and officials are expected to interact respectfully and with attention to each person's safety, both on and off the pitch. All persons will conduct themselves in a manner consistent with USGAA values and regulations. Anyone failing to do so may be required to leave the Tournament.

#### **Camogie Champion**

The teams in 1st and 2nd standing according to Tournament Points will advance to the Camogie Final. The Winner of the Camogie Final is the Camogie Champion, and will be awarded the Gerry and Connie McCrudden Memorial Cup.

#### **Hurling Champion**

The participating hurling teams are divided into two pools for round robin play. After all pool matches are complete, the teams in 3rd standing according to Tournament Points will play each other in the "Pint Final".

The teams in 1st and 2nd standing will advance to a semi-final match:

- Semi-Final A = Pool A 1st v Pool B 2nd
- Semi-Final B = Pool A 2nd v Pool B 1st

The winner of each semi-final match advances to the Hurling Final. The Winner of the Hurling Final is the Hurling Champion, and will be awarded the Gov. Thomas Burke Cup.

## **Match Format**

Pitch: Full-size GAA (approx. 130m x 72m), grass field

Hurling:  $13 \vee 13$ Camogie:  $11 \vee 11$ Unlimited rolling substitutions  $2 \times 15$ -min halves + 5-min halftime

In the event of a tie:

- Round robin: match ends in a draw. One tournament point to each team.
- Semi-final: Shootout.
- Final: 5-min break and 10-min overtime; if still tied after 10-min overtime, then shootout.
